

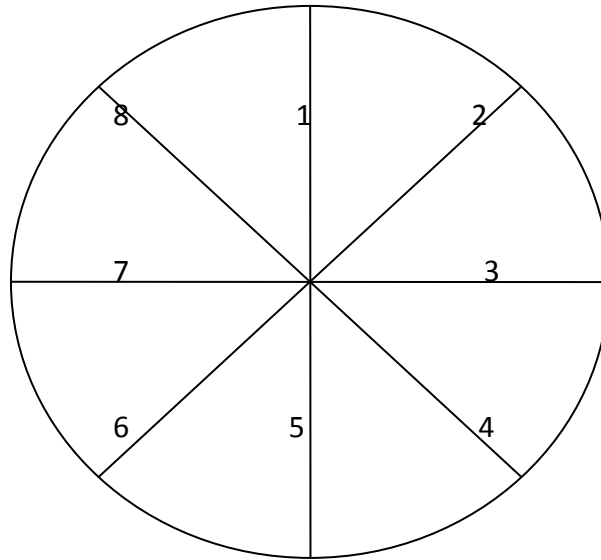
Evaluation Wheel for Transformative Evaluation
